Care Van Program

Our fleet of Care Vans canvas the state through partnerships with municipal and county health departments. They contribute to building healthy communities through basic services, educational outreach and health promotion. The Care Van brings public health services, such as no cost immunizations, dental sealants and health literacy, right to the community where people need them. The vans visit schools, churches, parks, shopping centers, public housing, community events and other locations. They conduct immunization and outreach clinics in communities where at-risk families live and work.

Each year, the BCBSIL Care Van program provides more than 10,000 immunizations and hundreds of dental sealants along with health literacy information on chronic conditions.
